A abbreviated starting sequence will be used. One-designs of 4 or more make a fleet. All others will sail to Portsmouth handicap.

ADVENTURE CLASS: A race that isn't about who is the fastest sailor! Participants will have tasks to perform to achieve a score in the race. This is for sailors who prefer a adventure over a race. Open to all skill levels. This is Saturday Only! You will need a fishing net and 10 water balloons.
